

SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING

Monday, March 21, 2016

Mayor Jason Mehmen called the meeting to order. Council members Orr, Meyer, Hanson, Ubben, and Jacobs were also in attendance.

Mayor Mehmen opened the Public hearing for the proposed budget. There being no comments or questions, the public hearing were closed. A motion by Orr, seconded by Meyer, to approve Resolution number 473-16 adopting the Fiscal year 2016-17 budget, carried with a roll call vote of all ayes.

Chad Oldenburger, Monroe 4-H club, gave options for the railing at the City Park. After discussion, a motion by Meyer, seconded by Jacobs, to approve a metal powdered railing, with a post every 6', manufactured by Thorne Metal Works for a cost of \$1800.00, carried unanimously. Railing will be finished and installed by June.

A motion by Meyer, seconded by Jacobs, to approve summer hire for up to 15 hours for the public works department, carried unanimously.

Before a decision to approve a utility cost of service study, the Council would like information on what is all included in the study.

Scott Poppen, Aplington Fire, informed the City Council of the recent officer elections, which includes: Scott Poppen – Fire Chief; Ken Mehmen – Assistant Chief; Denny Huisman, Red Dreesman, Tyler Nevenhoven, and Nick Koenen as Equipment, Training, and Safety Officers.

There being no further business, a motion by Meyer, seconded by Jacobs, to adjourn, carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 6 p.m.
