1. All connections with the sewer system, before being covered, shall be inspected and approved by the Public Works Department. No sewer pipe laid underground shall be covered or trenches filled until after the sewer pipe has been inspected and the pipe work approved by the Public Works Department. Upon said approval the trenches shall be immediately filled.
2. Outside drain tiles cannot be filled in until inspected and approved by the Public Works Department. Cement for the basement is not to be poured until the Public Works Department has made examination to discover drain tiles connected to the sanitary sewer which is expressly prohibited.
3. No water pipe laid under ground shall be covered or trenches filled until after the water has been turned into the pipe laid therein and such pipes have been tested and found water tight, and otherwise approved by the Public Works Department.
4. All water service lines must be of Type K Copper not less than ¾ inch in diameter from the existing water main to the water meter.
5. There will be a \$20.00 charge for an overhead electrical hookup and a \$70.00 charge for underground electrical hookup. Main disconnect furnished by owner.
6. There will be a \$100.00 charge for water hookup. Sewer paid for by property owner.
